

## **Frequently asked questions (FAQs)**

*"How old do I have to be to enter?"*

If you want to take part, you need to be aged 12 to 18 on the day (27<sup>th</sup> June). So if you were born between 28<sup>th</sup> June 1990 and 27<sup>th</sup> June 1997 you can be part of a team.

*"I'm 19 in May, can I still enter?"*

Leaders and Network members wishing to help with the event need to contact the organisation team as soon as possible by email ([monopolyrun@humbersidescouts.org.uk](mailto:monopolyrun@humbersidescouts.org.uk)).

*"Can we just pop in on Saturday night to Raywell?"*

Ermm, no - enter in a team!

*"Which meals do we get given?"*

*"Do I need a packed lunch?"*

*"Do I need to eat tea on Friday?"*

Thinking about your stomach again eh? We will provide Saturday breakfast, a light meal on Saturday evening as well as breakfast on Sunday morning - so if you want food on Friday you need to eat before you come to Raywell! You therefore need to sort out your own food on Saturday during the event - so you can bring a pack-up, or you can bring money and buy some lunch in Hull (feel free to buy ours too!)

*"Do we need tents?"*

Yes, you do need a tent, otherwise, you're on the grass (it's not that pleasant after a long day of activities) - you're Scouts and Explorers, of course you're not inside!!

*"Do I need walking boots?"*

If you want to wear them - sure (but we're not hiking, so trainers are fine too). Just remember you're staying at a campsite and you'll also be walking round Hull all day, so flip flops aren't practical.

*"Do I need cooking equipment?"*

So what we're providing isn't good enough? No, you don't need cooking equipment, or food that needs cooking.

*"What equipment do I need?"*

Well there's your clothing, wash kit, sleeping bag, tent, medication and torch etc. Also, each team will need a digital camera with a USB cable that fits the camera you are using (camera phones may not be used as software is needed to connect them to computers) and at least two mobile phones (with credit).

*"Will I need bus money?"*

No. You're walking from base to base. It's really, honestly, not far from each, but if you do need a break or to rest your legs, there's loads of places to have a sit down and chill out.

*"Do we need uniform?"*

You must wear a necker, visible at all times on the day. However, bring your uniform to Raywell, because you will need it.

*"I have difficulty walking for a long distance, can I still enter?"*

*"My team is all Scouts, do we need a leader?"*

*"We've got two Scouts and two explorers, and we don't want a leader, can we come without?"*

If your team is made up of just Scouts (aged 12 to 14) then you do not need a leader, providing that they think you are all able to travel without them. If you are a team of mixed (Scouts and Explorers) or if you are all Explorers, you cannot participate with a leader accompanying you.

*"What time can we arrive?"*

*"Can I be at Raywell at 6pm?"*

Arrival is from 7pm on the Friday, that's 7 - not 6, and please don't arrive too late, we do actually want to sleep. (Oh and while we're on topic, make sure you're gone by 12 noon on the Sunday - we'll be fed up of you by then).

*"What's the BP building?"*

As you enter Raywell Activity Centre at the SCOUTS entrance, it's the first building on your right. (It's really easy to find, honest, it's at the bottom of the hill, behind the climbing wall far away from the others at the top).

*"Are the challenges the same as last year?"*

Do you think we're daft? Wait and see!

*"I haven't got a team, can I still take part?"*

*"We haven't got a full team, what do we do?"*

Aww, sure! Fill in your PC form and make it clear you need a team, and we will stick you together with some others. Great chance to make friends!
