

# Air Rifle Courses for Leaders and helpers.

## NSRA Youth Proficiency Scheme – Instructor Certificate.

This is the minimum qualification required by the Scout Association for leaders wishing to supervise Scouts on an air rifle range.

### About the course.

The course is held over two days and is a combination of theory/discussion sessions and practical sessions on an air rifle range. Candidates will be expected to attend for the full course.

The course is accredited by the National Small-bore Rifle Association, the governing body for small-bore rifle and air rifle shooting in Britain, and is run by one of their tutors.

This qualification is valid for 5 years.

The minimum age for this course is 18 years.

### Cost £60

### Next course:

This will be held on October 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> 2010 at Raywell.

The course is non-residential but course members may arrange to camp on site at £1 per person per night (payable on site but should be booked in advance).

There is a maximum of 12 places on this course. Any additional applications will be held on a waiting list in case of cancellations or for a later course. Confirmation of places will be sent out on receipt of course fees. Joining instructions will be sent out 2-3 weeks before the date of the course.

Places may be provisionally reserved by e-mail or phone and will be held for 1 month to allow time for application form and payment to be received.

If you are awaiting funding from your Group/District send the application form and a place will be held provisionally for you and confirmed when your payment arrives.
