

Some questions answered . . .

Ok, so I want to have a go at the learning ! That's great :

1. Choose your method of learning
2. For a course fill in an application form (from Local Training Manager, Training Advisor or Group Scout Leader) and pass completed form to your local training manager (listed on the booking form),

Confirmation of your booking together with details about the course (e.g. directions etc) will be sent about two weeks before the course takes place.

3. For other methods of learning, such as DVD please see your Training Advisor or Local Training Manager or for the website option go to www.humbersidescouts.org.uk (select training)

Most of the courses, run by the Scout County of Humberside are free, but unfortunately there are a few where we have to ask for a bit of money, if so the cost is next to the course.

Don't forget to send us any money due with the booking form, cheques payable to "Humberside Scout Council".

Module 16, will cover the theory and planning of a nights away experience. To validate this you need to plan and run a nights away experience with a current Nights Away Permit holder.

Assessment for a Nights Away Permit will be arranged by your district Nights Away Advisor. Validation of Module 16 will be arranged by your Training Advisor.

All training is for anyone at any time, but to help you the courses are colour coded so you can have an idea who they are aimed at :

Modules in **green** are relevant to all appointments
Modules in **purple** are relevant to section leaders and supporters
Modules in **blue** are relevant to managers and supporters e.g. DC's, GSL's, ADC's, members of executive's and ACC's.
Modules in **orange** are relevant to all appointments and are supplementary courses that you may find useful to extend your skills and knowledge.
