In addition an opportunity has arisen for three adults to receive funded training via Humberside Scout Council, to be trained to the required level to join the County's Scout sailing team.

Training has been provisionally booked for the weekends of 20th / 21st and 27th / 28th May 2017. For anyone receiving funded training there will be an expectation of a commitment to supporting the team on a minimum of 4 sailing sessions and 1 maintenance session per year for three years.

As a team member you will become a County Skills Instructor. The appointment will necessitate the appointee to hold a current DBS which would be sourced via The Scout Association.
