## Sub Camps

Your Pack will be allocated to a sub camp, Packs that have requested being with others for catering etc. will be in the same sub camp.

To allow us to mark out the sub camps ready before your arrival could you please advise me the number of tents your Pack will be bringing as follows:

- Marquees
- Mess tents
- 2 man tents
- 4 man tents
- 6 man tents
- 8 man tents
- 12 man tents
- Patrol tents

We will be marking out the sub camps and putting up marquees on Sunday 22nd May from 9.00am. We need volunteers to help, could you please let me know if Leaders from your Pack will be able to come and join us.

You will be able to put your Pack tents up on Thursday night from 6.00pm

## Fires

There will be **no open fires** allowed on site including BBQs, could you all please make sure your gas pipes are not out of date.

## Toilets

We are bringing additional portaloos on site for the camp, however showers will be limited to the showers available in the toilet block.

## Registration

Arrival will start from 6.00pm on Friday and registration will take place in the jubilee building. Each Pack will require to bring the following:

- Sight of NAN form
- 2 copies of adult and cub health forms (one will be retained centrally in case of emergencies, and the other will be retained with the Pack). These are available from the website.
- Permission to shoot forms for all who wish to shoot, adults and young people, please see the form attached.

- Completed on site registration form

Each Pack will be given a Pack which will include the following:

- Camp programme
- Camp map showing activity zones and activities
- Sub camp neckers for each person booked onto the camp
- A camp badge for every member booked onto the camp

### **Activity Supervision**

The site will be split into four activity zones during Saturday and Sunday. Each sub camp will visit each zone area once, enabling all the young people to visit as many activities as possible.

There will be 10 activities in each zone which will be marked on the map that you will be given on registration.

We are expecting that the Packs will have no more than two people on cooking duties at their site so all other adults and young leaders should be able to help man activity bases during Saturday and Sunday. Activity base times are 9.30-12.00 and 14.00-16.30.

On Sunday we have circus skills activities coming to the site, every sub camp will have an allocated time slot for this activity. We will also be providing a few challenges around the site.

Could each Pack please provide an activity/challenge to run from 9.00 until 12.45. This could be anything from a Kim's game, tracking, ball game etc. It will be your Packs responsibility to run the base until all activities finish at 12.45

There will be a Leaders meeting at 21.00 on Friday, in the Jubilee building, please ensure one of your Leaders attends.
