

Humberside County Scout Council Risk Assessments

Guidelines associated with risk assessments

Humberside Scout Council (the County) is, through the Executive Committee and all levels of management, committed to ensure, so far as is reasonably practical, that risk assessments are undertaken for all activities at Raywell Park or provided by Humberside Scout Council.

Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of these risk assessments, it should be noted that:

- These risk assessments were undertaken on the date shown on each record;
- These risk assessments provide a 'snap-shot' view of the situation at the date given;
- Risk assessments are reviewed bi-annually by Humberside Scout Council;
- Humberside Scout Council encourage all users to conduct their own risk assessments prior to use of the site facilities to ensure that no further hazards or risks are evident at that time;
- Users are encouraged to inform the County Office of any anomalies found with any risk assessments.

This policy will be monitored to ensure it is effective and will be regularly reviewed and revised as necessary.
