# Austria Update Webinar



- We have a very early start on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> August! We will have several coaches come and pick people up from a nominated pick up point in/near their village/town. These coaches will then bring everyone to a central meeting point – the meeting time here is 7:30am so that we can reach our ferry in time. This means that your pick up will be earlier.

## ➤ Passports

- Please take a photocopy of your scouts' passport or even just a photo on your phone will be sufficient
- Passports will be checked at the first pick up point
- Passports will be kept in a safe box on each sub camp

## ➤ Medical details on OSM

- Please check the medical information on OSM and make sure it is up to date. This is very important!
- Please update the profile on OSM if there are any changes

## ➤ What3Words

This is optional, but you may wish to get your Scout to download the What3Words app onto their phone before we depart. This an easy way to identify precise locations. Every 3m square has been given a unique combination of three words: a what3words address that may be useful.

## ➤ Insurance

- We have insurance for all the travel and activities and everything that we will be doing. The only thing not provided is insurance for accessories such as tablets and mobile phones. These are optional to bring, and you may want to take out your own insurance on these. It may be included with your bank account too – check before you buy a separate policy.

## ➤ Mobile phones

Please note that there are no charging facilities at the campsite. If anyone wants to bring a phone, they will need to bring power banks or solar chargers to charge their phones. Phones will not be needed – they'll hopefully be too active to need their phones. We will keep in touch with parents back home every day via the Facebook page.

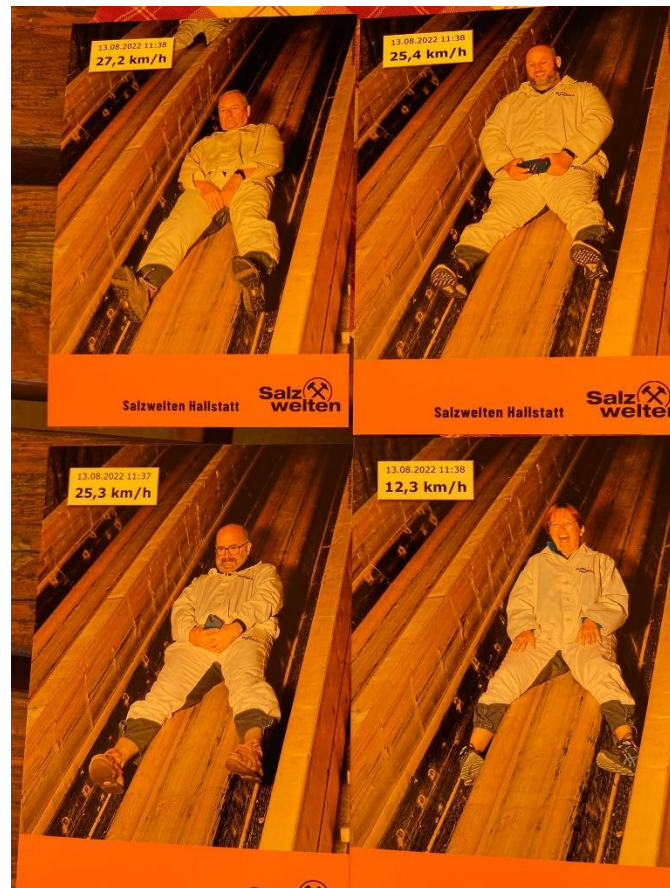
