





Expectations

Code of Conduct

In the event of repatriation being required, this will be at the parent/carer's expense and the parent/carer will be required to come and accompany their child home:

- Homesickness
- Serious misconduct: bullying, theft, etc.
- Any illegal activities (as per UK and other European laws)
- Any direction from Scouts HQ Team

Apart from:

- Medical issues, will be at our Insurer's cost
 - However, pre-existing conditions must be declared on OSM mental and physical health
 - Repatriation for undeclared medical conditions is likely to be at parents cost and could be very expensive

What happens next?

There is a limit on the overall number attending the trip due to the number of seats on a coach.

To ensure a fair process for all, bookings will open at 7:00pm on 6th December and places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis from then.

To secure your place you will need to complete the Booking Form, await your unique ID number generated after completing this form, then make the first payment of £149 via BACS, to the details provided in the email.
