

Slips / Trips / Falls	All	The Firearms Act 1968 (copy in County Office)	
Housekeeping	All	Check area clear of debris prior to use	
People being shot	All	All equipment to be checked before use	
People being hit with guns	All	Only qualified range instructors to use instruct on Range	
Ricocheting pellets	All	Parental Consent Forms (must be seen by range officer)	
Strains	Users	Minimum of one responsible adult with each group	
People entering range when others shooting	All	- In addition to range officer	
		Range officer has complete control at all times	
		- See 'Rifle Range - Supervisor notes'	
		Range officer to give safety talk prior to commencement	
		- See 'Rifle Range - Instruction to shooters'	
		First Aid kit available	
		PPE available (to current EN standards)	
		Leaders to keep control of group at all times	
		Shooting ceases if anyone enters range / whistle blown	
		- Rifles broken immediately shooting has stopped	
		Equipment is checked regularly	
		Activity to be run in accordance with current P.O.R.

		Damaged equipment recorded in the 'range log'
