

The rifles **MUST** be kept locked, within the cabinet in the rifle range

Keys will only be loaned to suitably qualified persons.

No more than four rifles should be drawn from the lockers at any time

Within the range the following procedure must be complied with:

- No more than four shooters will be allowed in the rifle range at any one time. Any other persons should assemble in the area outside. Adult leaders are allowed access to the range but must seek permission from the range Control Officer
- The Range Control Officer must give instructions exactly as they appear on the 'Instructions to shooters' card to all shooters **BEFORE** they handle the rifles
- The Range Control Officer must ensure that the gate between the shooting area and target area is securely and bolted closed and bolted before any pellets are issued and the inner door closed
- Before any change of shooters, the Range Officer must ensure that all rifles are broken and placed in the shooting direction.
- The log must be completed after every use and any suitable comments logged and the Range Control Officer must complete the session summary sheet and hand into the office
- Upon completion of the session, the rifles used **MUST** be locked in the cabinet and the keys returned.
