

The following instructions **MUST** be given to authorised participants before they have access to the rifles

The Range Control Officer has overall control of all activities on the range

Rifles must be treated with respect at all times; therefore the following must be adhered to:

- Any failure to comply with the rules will result in the offender being sent from the range without further notice;
- The rifles must be kept pointing towards the targets at all times and eye protection must be worn while shooting in the event of any pellet bounce back. Hands must be kept well clear of the pellet loading area when the rifle is being closed
- If a participant has any problems of any sort, they must put the rifle down on the shooting station, raise their hand and stand still;
- If the Range Control Officer calls a stop to shooting, the rifles must be put down on the shooting station in the shooting direction and the participants must stand still
